**To Achieve Level Two**

- Pass Level One rules tests online
- Plays each hole in 14 minutes per hole (300 max yardage) or less in groups of three, junior must accomplish or know the following:

**ON THE TEE** (Passing knows 7 of 10)

- names of clubs
- how to identify golf ball-puts identifying mark on ball
- shakes hands with fellow competitors (FC) and wishes them good luck
- where to stand and place clubs on the tee while watching others
- when it is their turn to play
- has club, tee and ball ready to play
- how to tee up golf ball
- one practice swing
- watches where ball goes
- how to carry clubs or push cart

**THROUGH THE GREEN** (passing knows 5 of 8)

- displays a sense of awareness and safety with FC
- moves quickly to ball, never out in front of other balls
- where to stand and place clubs
- when it is their turn to play
- has club ready to play
- one practice swing
- watches where ball goes
- repairs divots

**BUNKERS & HAZARDS** (passing knows 3 of 5)

- enters bunkers on low side of bunker
- plays without grounding club in hazard
- plays without removing loose impediments
- one practice swing
- rakes bunker

**PUTTING GREEN** (passing knows 9 of 13)

- lays clubs near the exit of each green on the way to the next tee
- how to repair a ball mark on the putting green
- how to mark a golf ball on the putting green
- how to replace a golf ball on the putting green
- how to move marker out of way of a FC
- stands facing or directly behind FC on putting green
- avoids line of putt for FC or self
- one practice swing
- attends flagstick while not standing on lines of FC
- first to hole out puts flagstick back in the hole
- exits putting green quickly to the next tee
- correctly keeps score for self on the next tee
- last hole played, remove hats, shake hands & thank for a nice round
